## Financial Assistance Checklist

Read:	It is absolutely important to complete <u>all</u> steps below to help in assembling sufficient evidence in support of your application for financial assistance. Bring all the listed documents, along with the completed application form, to CVSO office for consideration.
1.	<b>Eligibility: Completed financial assistance application form.</b>
2.	<b>Proof of Delinquency: Copy of most recent bills overdue payment.</b>
3.	<b>Proof of Rent: Copy of property lease, rental contract, or invoice.</b>
4.	<b>Proof of Income: Last 3 months of pay stubs for all in household.</b>
5.	<b>Proof of Net Worth: Copy of current savings and checking balance.</b>
6.	<b>Proof of Other Aid: Copy of approval/denial for all federal/local aid:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Social Security: including SSDI or SSI</li><li>- Unemployment</li><li>- Worker's Compensation</li><li>- Energy Assistance</li><li>- Food Share</li><li>- Good Will, Salvation Army, St Vincent DePaul, etc.</li><li>- American Legion, VFW, DAV, etc.</li></ul>
7.	<b>Proof of Obligation: Copy of satisfactory child support or maintenance payment history and/or of alimony payment history.</b>
8.	<b>Proof of Paid Debts to Government: Copy of paid-in-full receipt from any government agency owed any debt (i.e., overdue tax bills, unpaid court judgments, claims or fees, unpaid traffic fines, etc.)</b>
9.	<b>Evidence of Restitution: Copy of court's satisfaction for restitution ordered due to conviction for any fraud or misrepresentation in any application for public assistance from any State/Local government within the last 10 years or any that may appear on a CCAP inquiry.</b>
10.	<b>Copy of Driver's License or Picture ID of all household members over the age of 18 years old.</b>
