

## **January 8, 2015 TOWN OF LEWISTON BOARD MEETING MINUTES**

The Lewiston Town Board meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by Chairman Jon Steinhaus at the Lewiston Elementary School. All town officers present.

The agenda was reviewed. Jensen motioned to approve the agenda as presented. Motion Carried.

The minutes of the December 11 meeting were read by the clerk. Walker motioned to approve the minutes after correcting that \$800 bridge aid is for Klappstein Road, not Grotzke and adding that the option Lewiston has chosen for Implementing Act 377 regarding implements of husbandry is published as Option F of Act 377. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report was reviewed. The checking account balance was \$200,935.89 deposits were \$694,566.81 and checks were \$13,011.90 The CD balance is \$61,916.95

Planning commission: Lewiston's comprehensive plan will need to be updated to reflect zoning changes and other updates done since it was originally adopted. The Lewiston Planning Commission is working on drafting a driveway ordinance.

Roads: 2015 WI transportation aid will be \$102,204.92 and the Town has received the \$4000 in county highway aid for Grotzke Road. Snow plowing was discussed.

Alliant Energy emergency contact was discussed.

Real estate property tax and personal property tax refunds were discussed. Lexington Logistics LLC will be getting a refund on their 2013 personal property tax, after winning their appeal of the State's assessment.

Meeting recessed at 7:31PM to hold Caucus.

Meeting reconvened at 7:45 PM.

The Towns Bills were presented for payment. Jensen motioned to pay the bills as presented. Motion carried.

Walker motioned to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 8:00 PM
