Columbia County Solid Waste Committee November 03, 2014

Chairman Sleger called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. noting that the meeting had been properly noticed. Hutler made motion to approve the agenda as presented second by Baebler. Motion carried.

Minutes from the October 06, 2014 meeting were approved on motion by McClyman, second by Baebler. Motion carried.

Town of Pacific

Pacific Town Supervisor Craig Cawley stated the Highway 51/16 recycling site needs to be mowed and trash picked up. There were no other complaints.

Expenditures

Expenditures were presented for payment. Greg Kaminski reviewed each line item and answered questions. Motion was made by Collins, second by McClyman, to approve expenditures. Motion carried.

Budget and Compensatory Time

Greg Kaminski reported we did have some comp and overtime do to, three Huber and two regular employees coming in on a Saturday. We needed to process some recycling and get it prepared to be shipped out. We may do this again around the holidays.

October was a very good month. We are over our budget in all revenues. This includes the money we are receiving for the recycled metal from the steel drums.

Safety update

Greg Kaminski informed the committee that we have gone seventy five days without an injury. We did have one incident where one of our trucks hit a board on a garage. The carts need to remain three feet from the garage and three feet between the carts. Safety Meetings are focusing on cold weather concerns. Discussion followed.

Recycling Market

Kaminski reported we had our best month so far. We are \$11,000 dollars over our 2014 goal. We should be about \$50,000 dollars over our budgeted recycling revenue. We made 650.00 a ton on #2 plastic we shipped out. Greg Kaminski reported the markets are soft at this time. We are sitting on newspaper right now and hope to have it shipped out in November. We did get a good price on aluminum. Discussion followed.

Operations Report

Greg Kaminski passed around more pictures regarding the drum removal. We shipped out four loads of steel at \$200 a ton. We are half way through the project and hope to have it completed by early January.


Kaminski reported on the possible sale of Badger Disposal. It is uncertain at this time what impact it would have on our facility.

Kaminski has had meetings with the City of Wisconsin Dells regarding commercial and residential collection of garbage and recycling. He will be submitting a proposal and will keep the committee updated on the progress. Discussion followed.
