Columbia County Solid Waste Committee October 1, 2012

Approved Minutes

Present: Mark Sleger, Susanna Bradley, Ken Hutler, Phil Baebler and Robert McClyman

Also Present: Andy Ross-County Board Chair, Craig Cawley-Pacific Town Supervisor, Bill Casey and Carole Beix recording secretary.

Chairman Sleger called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. noting that the meeting had been properly noticed. Hutler made a motion to approve the agenda as presented second by McClyman. Motion carried.

Minutes from the August 6th meeting were approved on motion by Bradley, second by Hutler. Motion carried.

Town of Pacific

We received three odors during the months of August and September. Maintenance was being done on a drum and fans were on for ventilation. Discussion followed.

Expenditures

Expenditures were presented for payment. Motion to approve expenditure report as presented made by Bradley, second by Baebler. Motion carried. Casey was instructed to check into our long distance phone carrier to see if we could change everything over to Frontier.

Budgets and Compensatory Time

Compensatory time is in line with county policy

Budgets are good shape except for truck maintenance.

Casey informed the committee that the budget hearing with the finance committee went well and there were no issues to address regarding the 2013 budget.

Correspondence

In the month of November in the Village of Poynette we will be handing out educational fliers which the DNR requires us to do educating citizens about recycling, and we are

also including on the flier a change in the Thanksgiving holiday schedule of garbage and recycling pickup.

Casey has been contacted by the Village of Poynette regarding garbage and recycling carts. Discussion followed.

Recycling Market

Casey indicated that the recycling markets have dropped in the month of September with mills in a holding mode for now. The co-mingle price reflects the paper price which has dropped.

Operations Report

Handicapped and parking lines along with a directional line to the scale and compost area were painted this past week.

Drum #2 had been down for approximately 2 weeks due to a crack. Discussion followed.

Casey requested authorization to send out specs and get bids on two trucks and a loader prior to the 2013 budget being passed in November and to open bids on 10-29. Normal delivery time is approximately 4 months, but by having the bids published and opened this could speed up the delivery of the trucks to the early part of next year. Discussion followed. Motion was made by Hutler authorizing Casey to place the ad and to open bids on 10-29, second by Bradley. Motion carried.

Contractor was here repairing a header on the co-mingle door. Casey asked about repairing the metal sheeting in different areas of the building which were dented in when snow was being plowed it would roll and hit the building. Casey told the committee that over a period of time we would be put up four foot concrete walls in the problem areas to eliminate the situation. Discussion followed.

Casey informed the committee that the two 25,000 gallon tanks on the hill have been in for 22 years. One of the tanks will need to be inspected next year. Casey told the committee that the long range goal would be either put in fiberglass tanks or check to see whether a spray in liner could be used. Discussion followed.

The next Solid Waste Committee meeting will be Monday, November 5th, 2012 at 9:30 a.m.
