### Columbia County Solid Waste Committee March 4, 2013

#### **Approved Minutes**

**Present:** Mark Sleger, Susanna Bradley, Ken Hutler, Robert McClyman and Phil Baebler

**Also Present:** Andy Ross-County Board Chair, Craig Cawley-Pacific Town Supervisor, Greg Kaminski and Carole Beix recording secretary.

Chairman Sleger called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. noting that the meeting had been properly noticed. McClyman made a motion to approve the agenda as presented second by Hutler. Motion carried.

#### **Director Introduction**

Solid Waste Director Greg Kaminski introduced himself to the committee and gave a short history of his past work experience with Waste Management as a District Manager and One Source Recycling.

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**Recycling Market**

The month of February was a slow month due to the cold and snow. A load of cardboard is ready to go which did not get shipped out in February, and a load of tin is almost ready to ship with metal prices going up somewhat. We are looking at different ways to generate additional revenue from cardboard and plastic from the material received in single stream recycling. Discussion followed.

**Operations Report**

Kaminski informed the committee that he has been going to the different municipalities to introduce himself and to see if there are any issues, and Advanced Disposal-Horicon will be here on Thursday. Discussion followed.

Kaminski indicated to the committee that Warren Foth a consultant from Foth and Van Dyke had been asked to stop and take a tour of the facility to see if there was a need to update a study done about 10 years ago. Discussion followed. The committee agreed to wait at least six months to give the new director an opportunity to get familiar with the day to day operations and staff.

Kaminski stated that he felt it would advantageous for us and the public to change our start time to 7:30 a.m. Discussion followed. Motion was made by Bradley to move the start time to 7:30 a.m. for a period of six months and to report back in September, second by McClyman. Motion approved.

The next Solid Waste Committee meeting will be Monday, April 1st, 2013 at 9:30 a.m.
