### Columbia County Solid Waste Committee April 1, 2013

#### **Approved Minutes**

**Present:** Mark Sleger, Susanna Bradley, Ken Hutler, Robert McClyman and Phil Baebler

**Also Present:** Andy Ross-County Board Chair, Craig Cawley-Pacific Town Supervisor, Greg Kaminski and Carole Beix recording secretary.

Chairman Sleger called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. noting that the meeting had been properly noticed. Hutler made a motion to approve the agenda as presented second by McClyman. Motion carried.

Minutes from the March 4<sup>th</sup> meeting and March 20<sup>th</sup> special meeting were approved on motion by Bradley, second by Hutler. Motion carried.

#### **Town of Pacific**

No concerns or complaints.

#### **Expenditures**

Expenditures were presented for payment. Motion to approve expenditure report as presented made by Hutler, second by McClyman. Motion carried.

#### **Budgets and Compensatory Time**

Compensatory time is in line with county policy.

Budgets are in good shape.

#### **Correspondence**

Received notification from the DNR that we have been awarded a \$138,699 recycling grant.

Updated information had been forwarded to the DNR appointing Kaminski or designee to sign for Columbia County Solid Waste. The DNR wants only one person appointed to sign for the county.

### **Compliance Issues**

Back in 2010 a SSPC spill containment plan was put together. The federal government requires that we have a written plan documenting monthly inspections of vents and tanks. Discussion followed

Kaminski indicated to the committee that we may need a storm water run-off plan. Kaminski has been in contact with the Director of Land and Water regarding a run-off plan. Discussion followed.

### **Safety update**

Kaminski stated that he has been focusing on safety injury prevention with employees. Discussion followed. Committee would like monthly reports regarding injuries.

### **Landfill Reduction Recycling**

C & D Recycling Facility from Appleton stopped and spoke to Kaminski that they will take all pallets and clean wood for free. Discussion followed. Committee requested that Kaminski get a price quote for hauling of material and to also contact Dane County since they are using Landfill Reduction Recycling for their C & D Recycling.

### **Recycling Market**

The month of March was a better month. Employees are pulling out more cardboard and we have started to bale plastic anticipating that the market trend will be going up. In March we shipped out 2 loads of cardboard and 4 loads of papers. Kaminski informed the committee that he has contacted a new vendor for the sale of cardboard and paper.

### **Operations Report**

Advanced Disposal Horicon would like to enter into a Trans load agreement where they would bring in 75 to 100 ton of material per day and we would direct load the material onto semis with Advanced Disposal paying us \$5.00 per ton to load, and also mentioned that they would like to rent space from us to park vehicles. Kaminski feels this would be a good opportunity for additional revenue. Discussion followed.

The next Solid Waste Committee meeting will be Monday, May 6th, 2013 at 9:30 a.m.
