Columbia County Solid Waste Committee June 8, 2010

Approved Minutes

Present: Gerald Salzwedel, John Healy, Mark Sleger, Phil Baebler, Robert Andler

Also Present: Bill Casey, Craig Cawley Town of Pacific Supervisor, and Carole Beix recording secretary.

Chairman Healy called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. noting that the meeting had been properly noticed. Salzwedel made a motion to approve the agenda second by Baebler. Motion carried.

Minutes from the May 11th meeting were approved on motion by Andler, second by Baebler. Motion carried.

Town of Pacific

No complaints and no concerns.

Expenditures

Expenditures were presented for payment. Motion to approve expenditure report as presented made by Salzwedel, second by Baebler. Motion carried.

Budgets and Compensatory Time

Compensatory time is in line with county policy.

Budgets remain about the same with truck maintenance being higher than expected.

Correspondence

Casey received verbal correspondence from the DNR that CWD is becoming more prevalent in Columbia County. Beginning July 1st Columbia County will no longer be able to accept deer carcasses. A formal letter will be coming from the DNR to that effect. Discussion followed.

We are in the processing of renewing our garbage collection and recycling contract with the Village of Poynette. Discussion followed.

Casey handed out a bid comparison for uniform contract. We received 3 bids: Aramark, Cintas and G & K with Aramark's bid being the lowest. This is a 3 year contract which includes floor mats and shop towels, and uniform insurance. Consensus of the committee was to go with the low bid.

Casey was approached from a new computer business opening up to see if we would be interested in disposing of our computer equipment through them. Casey informed the committee that our present vendor guarantees that the hard drive is wiped cleaned. Casey was also concerned with the liability. Discussion followed. It was decided that we continue with our present vendor.

Recycling Market

Markets took a downward turn this last month, but still remain strong. Discussion was held on single stream recycling. Casey stated that since going to single stream recycling it has made it easier for residents, and it also keeps us competitive with other disposal companies and that there has been an increase in the amount of recyclables coming in.

Operation Report

Casey informed the committee that the welding and repairs to drum #2 have been completed and we are starting to fill the drum with garbage. Work will begin on drum #1 to replace some of the screens.

Truck maintenance seems to be getting caught up.

A conveyor belt was replaced.

Next Meeting Date


The next Solid Waste Committee meeting will be Tuesday, August 10th at 9:00 a.m.
