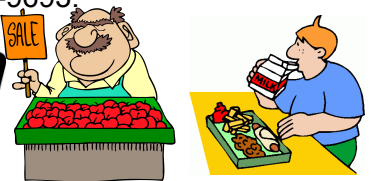
School Lunch Program

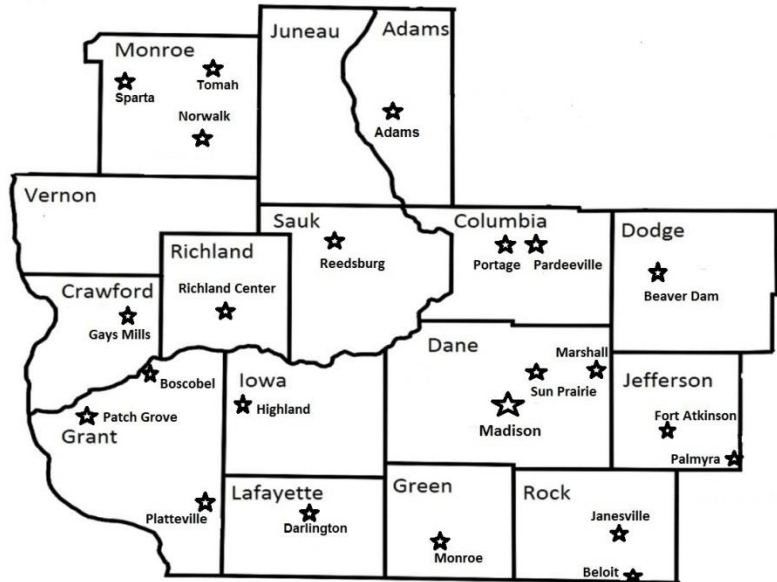

What is a mobile food pantry?

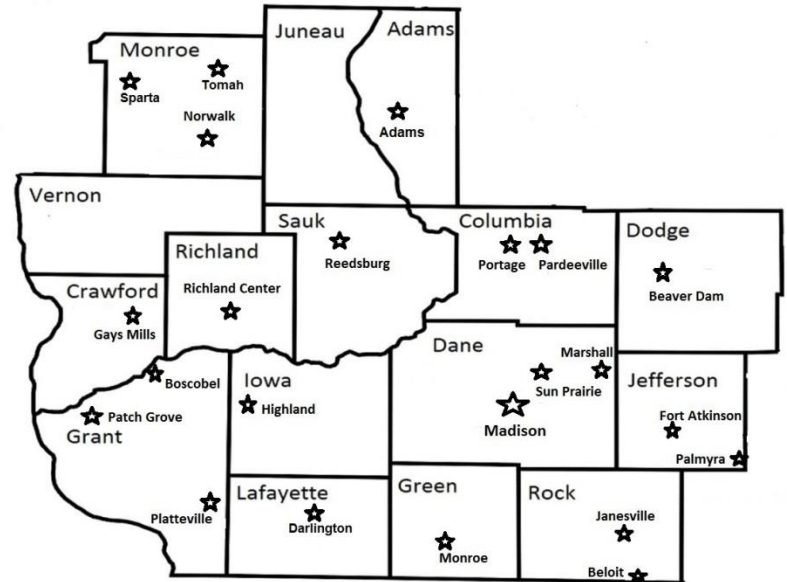
