FLU VACCINE FOR ADULTS

Columbia County Health and Human Services is offering quadrivalent preservative free flu shots on Mondays and Wednesdays from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm during our Public Health Walk In Clinics. The cost for the flu shot for adults is \$37.00. Please bring your Medicare card with you. We are not a Badgercare or Humana provider.

FREE FLU VACCINE FOR INFANTS AND CHILDREN

We are offering free quadrivalent preservative free flu shots from the Wisconsin Immunization Program for infants and children 6 months – 18 years of age who meet at least one of the following requirements: 1) Uninsured or Underinsured (underinsured means your child has health insurance but it doesn't cover flu vaccine 2) Medicaid-eligible (including BadgerCare) or 3) Native American or Alaska Native.
