PROJECT LIFESAVER PROGRAM

The Columbia County Sheriff's Office is proud to announce the implementation of a program called "Project Lifesaver." The Project Lifesaver Program is a locator system where an at-risk individual (Alzheimer's, Dementia, child with Autism or Down's Syndrome, etc.) is issued a special tracking bracelet that can be located by a specially trained team equipped with a tracking device receiver should they go missing.

The Project Lifesaver Program is being administered and supported only by donations at this time. Donations are welcome at any time and they may include:
