



## **PUBLIC NOTICE:**

**What: Wendt Road closed to all traffic**  
**When: Monday, May 2, 2022**  
**Where: Bridge crossing Crawfish River  
(1/4 MILE SOUTH OF DUBORG ROAD)**  
**Why: Bridge Replacement Project**  
**Duration: Re-opens approximately July 1, 2022**

Beginning Monday, May 2, 2022, Wendt Road in the Town of Columbus will be closed to traffic at the bridge over the Crawfish River. Closure is necessary in order to complete the replacement of the existing structure. Work is anticipated to last for 70 working days or until approximately July 1, 2022. Road will be re-opened for traffic upon completion of the work. No detour is being posted, traffic will need to re-route on their own accord. Completion timeline is weather dependent.

Work is being completed in cooperation of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Town of Columbus, and Columbia County Highway & Transportation Department as part of the State Transportation Improvement Program.

Every effort is being made to minimize disruptions to traffic patterns and timing while still being able to complete the project in an efficient and cost-effective manner.
