WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Legislature has established a "Smart Growth Law" that requires the Town of Arlington to develop a comprehensive plan in accordance with Chapter 66.1001 of the Wisconsin State Statutes, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Arlington has assigned the developing of a plan consistent with the requirements specified by law to the Town of Arlington Planning Commission, and

WHEREAS, the governing local body of a local government shall adopt written procedures that are designed to foster public participation during the preparation of a comprehensive plan, and

WHEREAS, this resolution shall constitute the written procedures designed to foster public participation in accordance with Chapter 66.1001 (4)(a) of the Wisconsin State Statutes;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that public participation in the development of the Town of Arlington Comprehensive Plan may include, but not be limited to the following activities: a County community opinion survey, Town public meetings, news releases, Town of Arlington Planning Commission meetings and other open meetings for which the public is entitled to have advanced notice. In addition, all informational items used and produced by Town of Arlington Planning Commission shall be made available for public review at the Columbia County Planning and Zoning Department and the Town of Arlington Town Office. Written comments on all subjects pertaining to the development of this plan shall be encouraged. An address to forward written comments shall be provided in meeting notices and news releases. Town of Arlington Planning Commission shall respond to written comments at public meetings.

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-5-7

TOWN OF ARLINGTON
COLUMBIA COUNTY, WISCONSIN

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE THE TOWN OF ARLINGTON PLAN
COMMISSION.

The Town Board of the Town of Arlington, Columbia County, Wisconsin does hereby create and ordain as follows:

Title/Purpose

The title of this ordinance is "Town of Arlington Plan Commission Ordinance".

The purpose is to establish a Town of Arlington Plan Commission and set forth its organization, powers and duties to further the healthy, safety, welfare and wise use of resources for the benefit of current and future residents of the Town and affected neighboring jurisdictions, through the adoption and implementation of comprehensive planning with significant citizen involvement.

Authority

The Town Board of the Town of Arlington, having been authorized by the Town meeting under sec. 60.10(2){c}, Wis. Stats., to exercise village powers, hereby exercises village powers under sec.60.22(3), Wis. Stats., and establishes a seven (7) member Plan Commission under secs. 61.35 and 62.23, Wis. Stats. The Plan Commission shall be considered the "Town Planning Agency" under secs. 236.02(13) and 236.45m Wis. Stats., which authorize, but do not require, Town adoption of a subdivision or other land division ordinance.

Description

The Plan Commission consists of one (1) member of the Town Board, who may be the Town Board Chairperson, and six (6) citizen members, who are not otherwise town officials, and who shall be persons of recognized experience and qualifications.

The Town Board Chairperson will appoint Plan Commission members to staggered terms of office of one (1), two (2), or three (3) years and will appoint the Plan Commission Chairperson.

Further detail regarding the rules and responsibilities governing a Plan Commission is available from the Town Clerk.

Effective Date

This ordinance shall become effective as provided by law and upon publication.

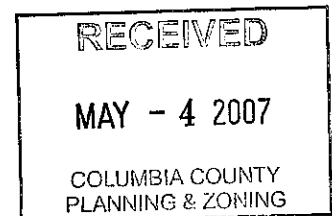

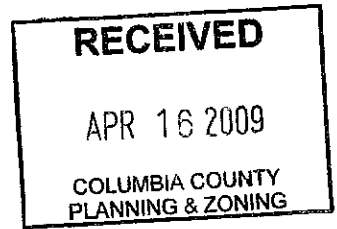

Ordinance No. 2009-04-14

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

The Town Board of the Town of Arlington, Columbia County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

Recitals

A. Pursuant to Sections 60.22(3) and 62.23(2) and (3), the Town of Arlington is authorized to prepare and adopt a Comprehensive Plan as defined in Sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2), Wisconsin Statutes; and

B. The Town Board of the Town of Arlington has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation at every stage of the preparation of the Comprehensive Plan as required by Section 66.1001(4), Wisconsin Statutes; and

C. The Plan Commission (Planning Committee) of the Town of Arlington by a majority vote of the entire Commission recorded in its official minutes, adopted a Resolution recommending to the Town Board adoption of the document entitled "Town of Arlington Comprehensive Plan 2030"; and

D. The Town has held at least one public hearing on this Ordinance, in compliance with the requirements of Section 66.1001(4)(d), Wisconsin Statutes, and provided other opportunities for public involvement per its participation strategy and procedures; and

E. The Town of Arlington Comprehensive Plan 2030 contains all of the elements specified in Section 66.1001(2), Wisconsin Statutes;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO SECTION 66.1001(4), WISCONSIN STATUTES, THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF ARLINGTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Ordinance

1. The document entitled "Town of Arlington Comprehensive Plan 2030" is adopted as the Town's Comprehensive Plan under Section 66.1001(4), Wisconsin Statutes.

2. The Town Clerk is directed to file a copy of this Ordinance and the Town of Arlington Comprehensive Plan 2030 with all of the entities specified in Section 66.1001(4)(b), Wisconsin Statutes.

3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Town Board and publication/posting as required by law.

The foregoing Ordinance was duly adopted by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Town Board of the Town of Arlington at a meeting held on April 14, 2009.
