






















MAP 5-1 LANDS ENROLLED IN FARMLAND PRESERVATION






MAP 5-3 LANDS ENROLLED IN WETLAND RESERVE PROGRAM





MAP 5-6 PRODUCTIVE AGRICULTURAL SOILS Columbia County Wisconsin









MAP 5-9 STREAMS, SURFACE WATER & WATERSHEDS Columbia County Wisconsin












MAP 5-12 WOODLANDS




