

To: CDBG Housing Program Contractors

If you are awarded a CDBG project, you will be required to submit the following information, as applicable:

- Copy of Asbestos Certificate and Card from DHS for employee(s) working on the project.
 - If you are not asbestos trained, you can sub-contract any work identified as containing asbestos (such as roof, flooring, etc.); however, the subcontractor must be able to provide the appropriate certifications.
- Copy of Asbestos Certificate for company
- Copy of Lead Safe Renovator Certificate and Card from DHS for employee(s) working on the project.
 - If you are not lead trained, you can sub-contract any work identified as containing lead based paint (such as windows, siding, etc.); however, the subcontractor must be able to provide the appropriate certifications.
- Copy of Lead Certificate for company
- Insurance Certificate for the general contractor as well as all sub-contractors
- Licenses for the general contractor as well as all subcontractors, as applicable

Typically, one completed bid should be submitted per contractor, including all electrical, heating, plumbing and general work. The general contractor is responsible for obtaining all certifications, licenses, insurances and lien waivers from the sub-contractors.

The attached green sheets are the contractor eligibility form and a list of communities where MSA administers housing programs throughout Wisconsin. If you are interested in working with our program, please fill out the form and mail it back to me as soon as possible. The homeowners are able to choose the contractors they want to bid on their project but we have a very limited number of trained contractors at this time working with the program.
