The meeting of the Ad Hoc Ordinance Review and Recodification Committee was called to order by Chair Rohrbeck at 1:05 p.m. The meeting was properly noticed as required by the Wisconsin Open Meetings Law. Approval of Agenda

Approval of Minutes

Motion by Shimpach to approve the minutes of the August 28, 2020 Ad Hoc Ordinance Review and Recodification Committee meeting. Second by Brusveen. Motion carried.

Review of County Ordinances – Titles 15 & 16

Hale lead the discussion on the revised ordinances. Each chapter was reviewed as presented with any changes or modifications listed as follows:

Former Title 15 – Animal Waste Management – Calkins and Hale discussed and referred to tab 23, second binder reference.

- Calkins referenced the summary document. Since 1985, the revisions started. The ordinance went from earthen materials to materials involved. Calkins gave some examples of manure storage structure need. The State had made some changes in 2002. In 2018, 313 was revised by the federal government, with concerns on implementing it. They are proposing the new version of the ordinance, this includes the 2002 revisions and 2011 changes.
- Sec. Change in title adding performance standards and ag waste management.
- Definitions update in wording.
- Agency switched from committee.
- New addition to ordinance adding direct conduit to groundwater.
- Manure storage structures, no 17
- Phosphorus Index is new
- Process Wastewater
