Columbia County Solid Waste Committee April 3, 2024

Expenditures

Expenditures were presented for payment. Kaminski reviewed each line item and answered questions. The total for the months of January and March was \$232,287,89. Motion was made by Baumgartner to approve expenditures, second by Groves. Motion carried.

Kaminski stated that we continue to have compensation time and overtime and the recycling line on order to keep up with processing incoming volume.

Kaminski reviewed the budget and stated that it is on track through the first quarter of 2024. Discussion followed.

Safety Update

Kaminski reported there were no injuries or accidents in March. We have now gone more than 8 months without an injury. Discussion followed.

Recycling Markets Update

Kaminski reported recycling revenue for the month of March was \$22,487.30. Several loads did not ship in March which will be added to April. Carboard and paper markets continue to be strong but plastic and metal have been weak. Discussion followed.

Fire Update

Kaminski provided updated information on the fires answered questions from Committee members. We will have preliminary pricing for the new buildings soon. Discussion followed.

Position Replacement Request- Driver (2)

Motion by Baumgartner to approve replacement of two driver positions, second by Groves. Motion carried.

Approve Change to Fee Ordinance

Motion by Baumgartner to approve change to fee ordinance increasing the tire rate from \$285 per ton to \$385 per ton, second by Groves. Motion carried.

Operations Report

Kaminski stated that installation of the fabric structure over the transfer station has been completed.
Garbage and recycling service for Saddle Ridge Condominium Association began on April 1.
