- **5 - YEAR COORDINATED PLAN DISCUSSION**
The 5-year coordinated plan is based on community feedback. Currently there is not an option within Columbia County that provides bariatric wheelchair transport. Discussed the limitations of the ADRC driver's ability to safely provide bariatric transport. Discussed volunteerism in all categories being at a low due to COVID and other factors. Discussed reaching out to MATC to see if an intern opportunity for medical transport for an EMS course could be offered. The TRIP Council members were asked to research resources for transportation, both medical and social in their community and to report at the next meeting. The ADRC Transportation Coordinator provides resources to consumers as needed.


