Joint Columbia County Information Services and Property Committee & Human Resources Committee Minutes December 21, 2016

The joint meeting of the Information Services and Property Committee was called to order by Chair Hutler and the meeting of the Human Resources Committee was called to order by Chair Rashke at 9:15 a.m. The meeting was properly noticed as required by the Wisconsin Open Meetings Law. The meeting was held at the Administration Building, County Board Conference Room, 400 DeWitt Street, Portage, WI.

Maintenance Mechanics Step Placement

Wiegel requested to increase 2 maintenance mechanic positions to Step 6 of the pay scale. The increase would be approximately \$7,466 a year for the 2 positions. He stated both positions are currently filled by county employees and the step increase would entice the current employees to remain with the County instead of seeking employment elsewhere. Ruf stated the County has experienced no problems in the past hiring to fill previous vacant positions and sees no problems doing so in the near future. Ruf explained the process if the Information Services and Property Committee recommends the step increase, the Human Resources Committee will need to recommend the compensation pay.

Motion by Ross to deny the step placement request for the maintenance mechanics. Second by Rashke. Motion carried.

No action was taken by the Human Resources Committee.

The joint committee meeting adjourned at 9:25 a.m.
