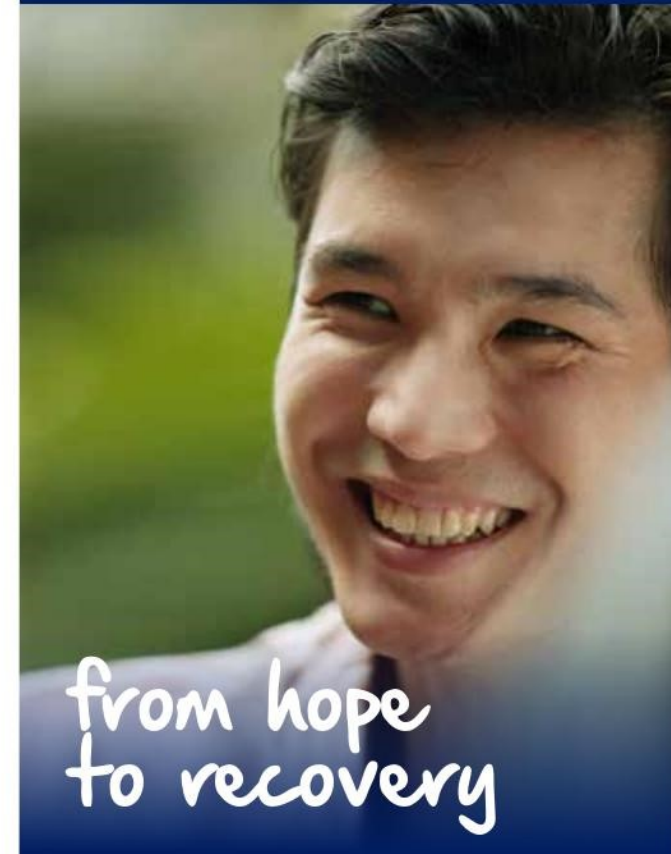

Journey's Columbia County Community Support Program (CSP) is certified by the Wisconsin Department of Health and Long Term Services to provide comprehensive mental health, co-occurring substance use and case management services to adults diagnosed with a serious mental illness.

Eligibility for Journey's Columbia County CSP is established only after consistent and extensive efforts to have been made to successfully treat the person in a lower level of care.



## Our Focus

We focus on recovery through providing well-rounded care in the least restrictive environment possible. Our services include:

- Psychiatric evaluation and assessment.
- Professional assistance with medication care and resources.
- Teaching skills that help people problem solve, deal with stress, understand illness, and develop new ways to manage and cope with their illness.
- Identifying work related interests and skills, and help in developing interests that could grow into possible employment
- Connections to community resources that allow consumers to live alone, travel in the community successfully, and get necessary items like food, personal care items, clothing and more.
