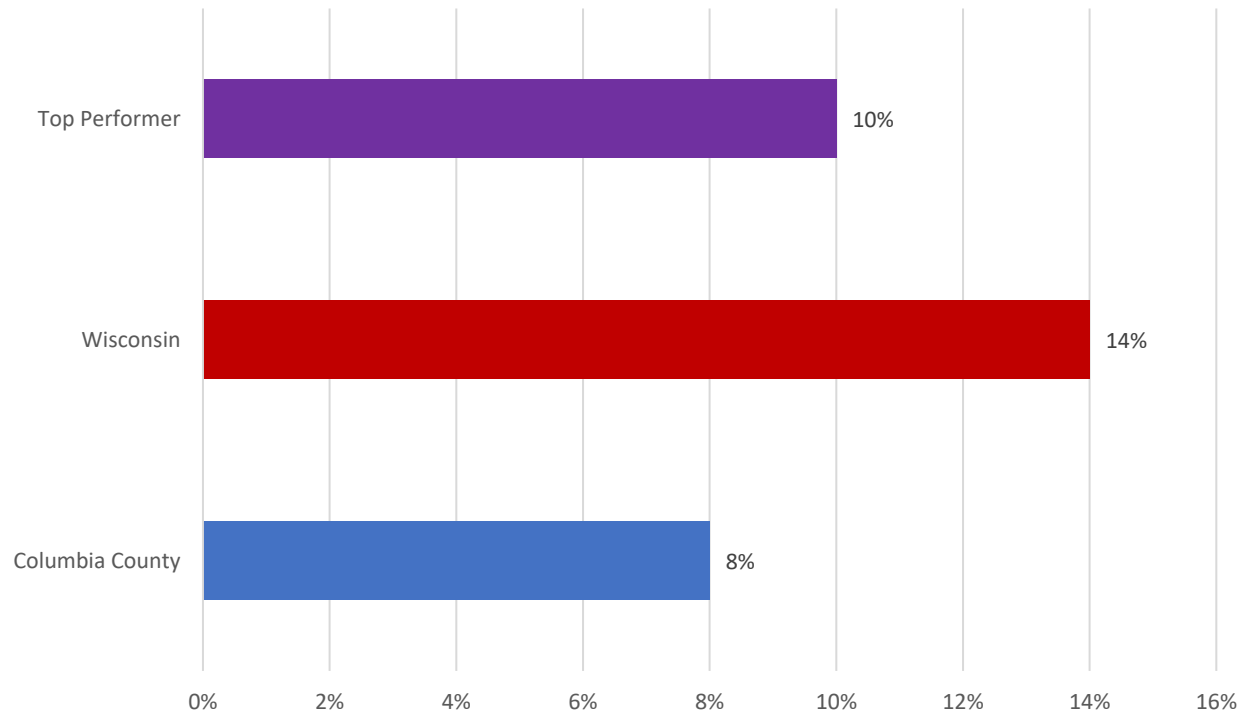

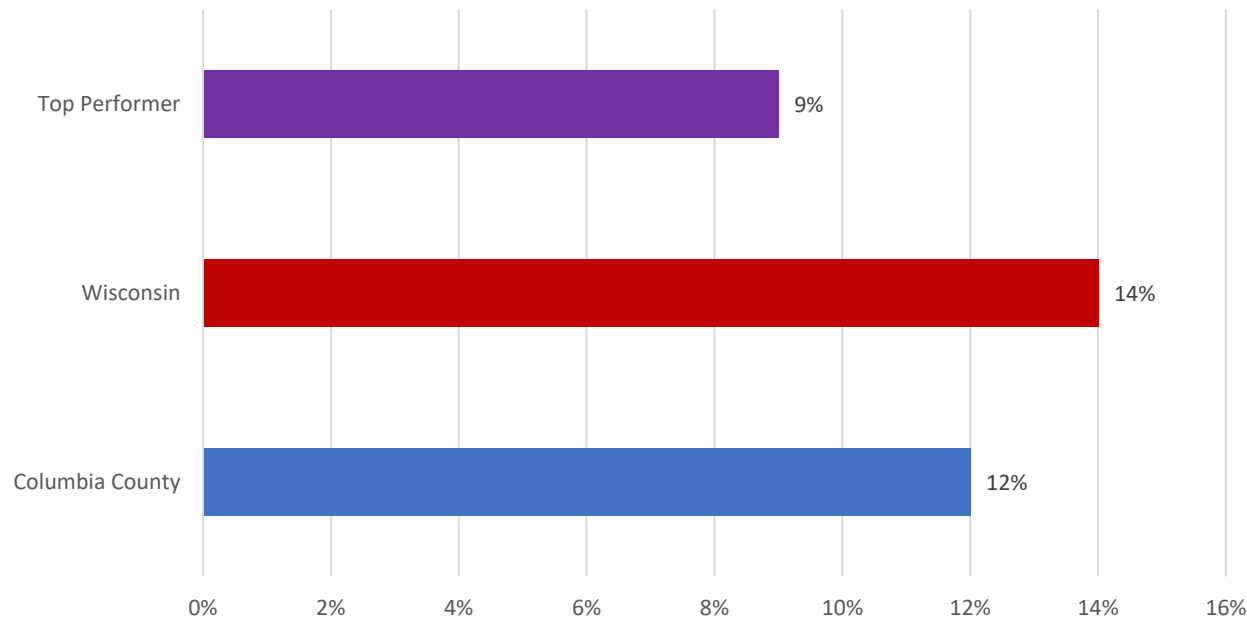

**Poverty Rate** – Percent of children living below the Federal Poverty Line (FPL)



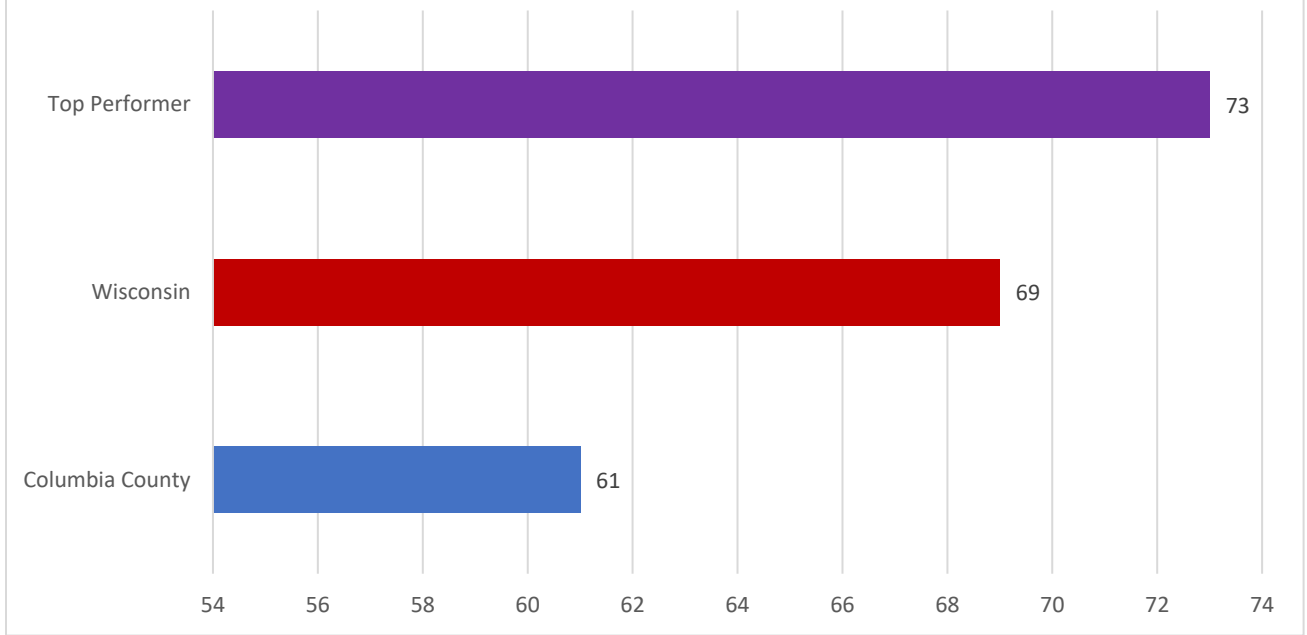

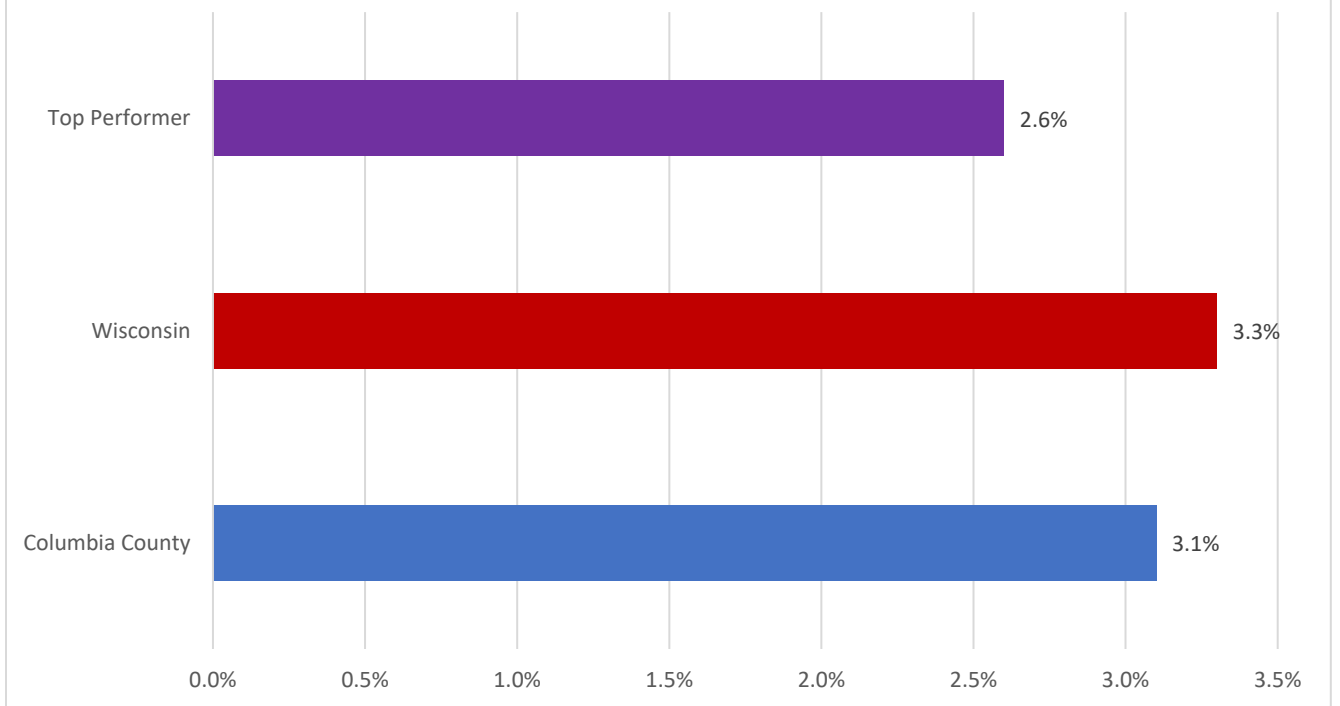

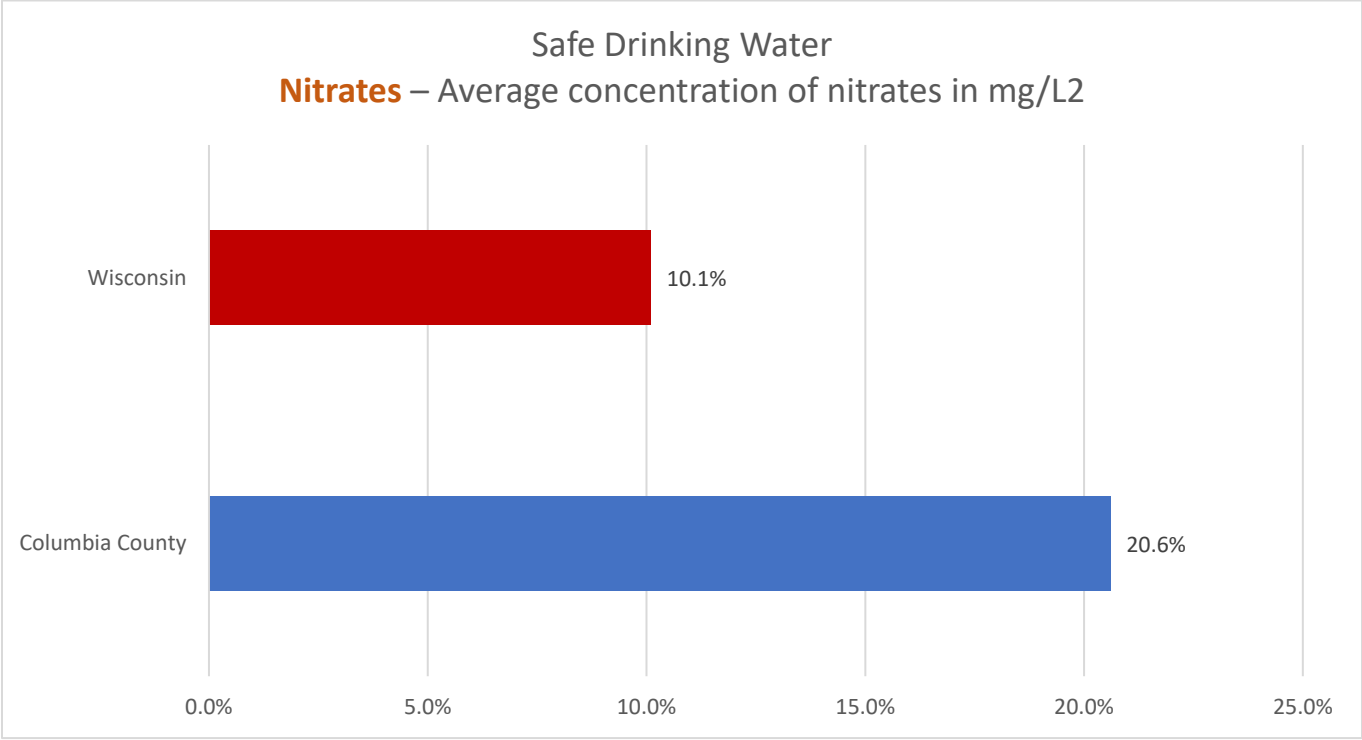

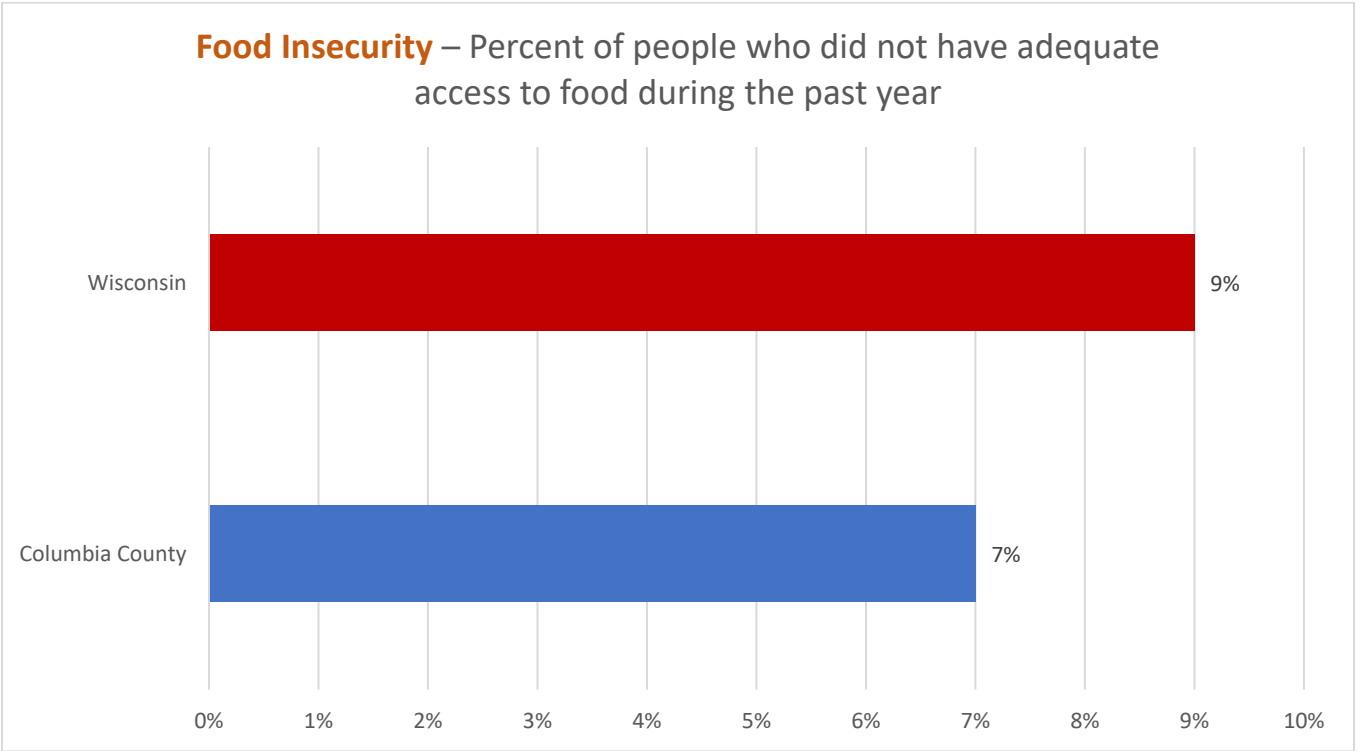


**Unemployment Rate** – Percent of population age 16+ unemployed but seeking work

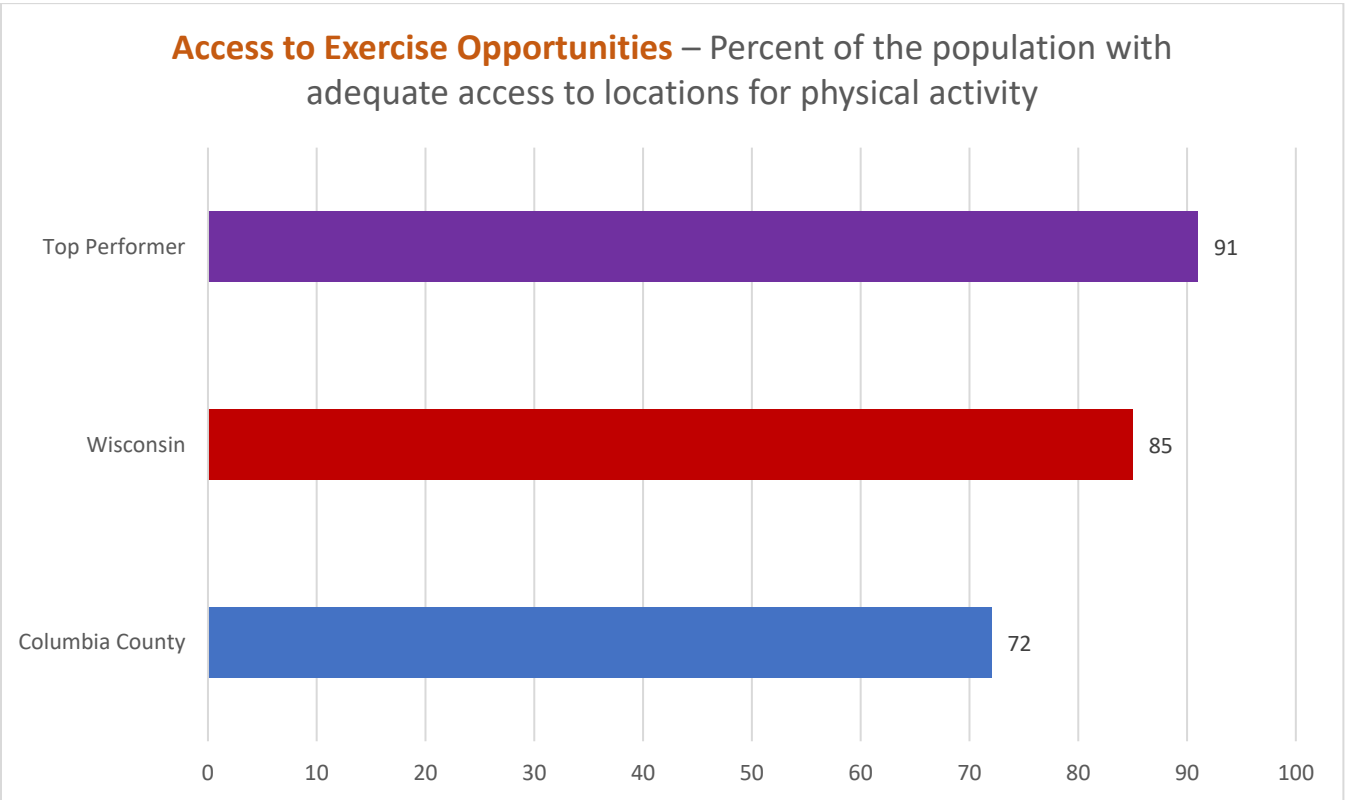
