

## Crisis Services

Columbia County contracts with Northwest Connections to provide emergency mental health and substance use services on a twenty-four hour basis for residents of Columbia County. Northwest Connections is available 24 hours a day by dialing 1-888-552-6642. Mobile crisis services are also available when or if necessary to assess risk and assist in the development of a safety plan.

Columbia County Health and Human Services provides short term case management following a crisis call to link adults and youth with ongoing supportive services and natural supports.

## How Can I Get Help?

### **If you have insurance:**

You should call the number on your insurance card and ask for your covered benefits for your behavioral health need and what providers are covered with your insurance. You may contact Columbia County Health and Human Services if you need assistance completing this call.

### **If you do not currently have insurance:**

You may contact the Capital Consortium by dialing 1-888-794-5556, to explain your situation and inquire if you are eligible for Medicaid.

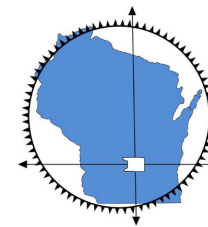

## Access to Mental Health and Substance Use Services

### Comprehensive Community Services (CCS)

CCS provides community based case management for adults or youth with a mental health or substance use diagnosis to assist them in reaching goals they have set for themselves.

### Community Support Program (CSP)

CSP provides community based case management to adults with severe and persistent mental illness (such as schizophrenia, major depression, or bipolar disorder).

### Case Management

Columbia County provides targeted case management for adults and youth who have a mental health or substance use diagnosis which significantly impacts their daily life.
