COLUMBIA COUNTY COVID-19 WEEKLY UPDATE

Key COVID-19 Data Summary for Columbia County as of January 6th , 2021 10:00 a.m.

- Total confirmed positive test results: 4,342 (+169 since 12/30/20)
(Includes active, recovered, deceased)
- Active cases: 195 (+15 since 12/30/20)
- Total probable test results 315 (+21 since 12/30/20)
- Total ever hospitalized 216 (+11 since 12/30/20)
- Individuals recovered: 4114 (+151 since 12/30/20)
- Total deaths of people confirmed positive: 33 (+3 since 12/30/20)
- Total deaths of people probable results 6 (+1 since 12/30/20)
- Total negative cases: 24205 (+255 since 12/30/20)
- Total number of active investigations by setting: 41 (-13 since 12/30/20)
Educational facility -12; Long-term care facility -9; Workplace (non-health care) -14; Group housing facility -2; Health care facility -2; Other setting -2.
- COVID-19 Activity Level **VERY HIGH** (Same as 12/30/20)

What age groups in Columbia County are testing positive for COVID-19?

As of 1/6/2021 at 10:00 a.m., the 4342 persons testing positive per age group were:

0-9 years old- 160 persons (3.7%)	50-59 years old – 731 persons (16.8%)
10-19 years old – 484 persons (11.1%)	60-69 years old – 466 persons (10.7%)
20-29 years old – 744 persons (17.1%)	70-79 years old – 254 persons (5.8%)
30-39 years old – 723 persons (16.7%)	80-89 years old – 106 persons (2.4%)
40-49 years old – 640 persons (14.7%)	90 plus years old – 34 persons (0.8%)
