Key COVID-19 Data Summary for Columbia County as of January 20th 10:00 a.m.

- Total confirmed positive test results: 4664 (+128 since 1/14/21)
(Includes active, recovered, deceased)
- Active cases: 210 (-2 since 1/14/21)
- Total probable test results 354 (+15 since 1/14/21)
- Total ever hospitalized 237 (+9 since 1/14/21)
- Individuals recovered: 4,415 (+127 since 1/14/21)
- Total deaths of people confirmed positive: 38 (+3 since 1/14/21)
- Total deaths of people probable results 6 (+0 since 1/14/21)
- Total negative cases: 24983 (+368 since 1/14/21)
- Total number of active investigations by setting: 49 (+6 since 1/14/21)
Educational facility -13; Long-term care facility -7; Workplace (non-health care) -20; Group housing facility -2; Health care facility -2; Other setting -5.

What age groups in Columbia County are testing positive for COVID-19?

As of 1/19/2021 at 10:00 a.m., the 4173 persons testing positive per age group were:

0-9 years old- 171 persons (3.7%)	50-59 years old – 799 persons (17.1%)
10-19 years old – 519 persons (11.1%)	60-69 years old – 501 persons (10.7%)
20-29 years old – 787 persons (16.9%)	70-79 years old – 269 persons (5.8%)
30-39 years old – 772 persons (16.6%)	80-89 years old – 117 persons (2.5%)
40-49 years old – 693 persons (14.9%)	90 plus years old – 36 persons (0.8%)
