Columbia County Public Health Holds COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic

Portage, WI - On February 11, 2021, Columbia County Public Health held their first COVID-19 vaccination clinic where 200 Phase 1A eligible clients were vaccinated.

We will begin scheduling vaccination appointments for the next clinic for the remaining Phase 1A and 65+ **beginning Monday, February 15, 2021, at 1:00 pm.** To schedule an appointment, you may call the Health & Human Services at (608) 742-9227. You will need to provide a phone number and/or an email address when calling to schedule.

As we work through scheduling the adults 65+, please note that there are 700,000 people in Wisconsin who fall into this age group, but Wisconsin is still only receiving limited allocations of the vaccine. Not everyone in this age group will be able to be vaccinated immediately. We encourage you to reach out to your local provider for availability as well.

Please note that because of the limited amount of doses of vaccination being allocated, we may have to stop taking appointments and ask you to call back when additional future clinics are scheduled. Thank you in advance for your patience.

The clinics will be held at the Health & Human Services at 111 E. Mullett Street, Portage, WI (ADRC Entrance) by appointment only. You will be provided complete instructions at your time of scheduling.
