As of 2/10/2021 at 10:00 a.m., the 4,921 persons testing positive per age group were:

0-9 years old - 186 persons (3.8%)	50-59 years old – 842 persons (17.1%)
10-19 years old – 564 persons (11.5%)	60-69 years old – 536 persons (10.9%)
20-29 years old – 811 persons (16.5%)	70-79 years old – 285 persons (5.8%)
30-39 years old – 811 persons (16.5%)	80-89 years old – 122 persons (2.5%)
40-49 years old – 726 persons (14.8%)	90 plus years old – 38 persons (0.8%)
