- Total confirmed positive test results: 5,052 (+47 since 2/24/21)
(Includes active, recovered, deceased)
- Active cases: 56 (0 since 2/24/21)
- Total probable test results: 378 (0 since 2/24/21)
- Total ever hospitalized: 273 (+3 since 2/24/21)
- Individuals recovered: 4,942 (+45 since 2/24/21)
- Total deaths of people confirmed positive: 53 (+2 since 2/24/21)
- Total deaths of people probable results: 11 (+2 since 2/24/21)
- Total negative cases: 26,587 (+155 since 2/24/21)
- Total number of active investigations by setting: 32 (-1 since 2/24/21)
