- Total confirmed positive test results: 5,118 (+32 since 3/10/21)
(Includes active, recovered, deceased)
- Active cases: 39 (-9 since 3/10/21)
- Total probable test results: 379 (+1 since 3/10/21)
- Total ever hospitalized: 281(+2 since 3/10/21)
- Individuals recovered: 5,023 (+40 since 3/10/21)
- Total deaths of people confirmed positive: 55 (+1 since 3/10/21)
- Total deaths of people probable results: 12 (0 since 3/10/21)
- Total negative cases: 26,863 (+130 since 3/10/21)
- Total number of active investigations by setting: 14 (-3 since 3/10/21)
