- Total confirmed positive test results: 5,268 (+109 since 3/24/21)
(Includes active, recovered, deceased)
- Active cases: 60 (+21 since 3/24/21)
- Total probable test results: 388 (+7 since 3/24/21)
- Total ever hospitalized: 289 (+7 since 3/24/21)
- Individuals recovered: 5,150 (+87 since 3/24/21)
- Total deaths of people confirmed positive: 57 (+1 since 3/24/21)
- Total deaths of people probable results: 12 (0 since 3/24/21)
- Total negative cases: 27,548 (+586 since 3/24/21)
- Total number of active investigations by setting: 10 (-8 since 3/24/21)
