#### Key COVID-19 Data Summary for Columbia County as of September 15 , 2021

- Total confirmed positive test results: 6,257 (+208 since 9/8/21)  
(Includes active, recovered, deceased)
- Active cases: 303 (+110 since 9/8/21)
- Total probable test results: 451 (+16 since 9/8/21)
- Total ever hospitalized: 385 (+7 since 9/8/21)
- Individuals recovered: 5,890 (+98 since 9/8/21)
- Total deaths of people confirmed positive: 62 (+0 since 9/8/21)
- Total deaths of people probable results: 13 (+0 since 9/8/21)
- Total number of active investigations by setting: 20 (+12 since 9/8/21)  
Educational facility -7; Long-term care facility -3; Workplace (non-health care) -6; Group housing facility -1; Health care facility -0; Other setting -3
- COVID-19 Activity Level **VERY HIGH**

<u>Total Vaccine Doses for Columbia County:</u>	64,914
<u>Columbia County Residents who have received at least one dose:</u>	34,429 (59.8%)
<u>Columbia County Residents who have been fully vaccinated:</u>	32,561 (56.6%)
