#### Key COVID-19 Data Summary for Columbia County as of September 29 , 2021

- Total confirmed positive test results: 6,799 (+542 since 9/15/21)  
(Includes active, recovered, deceased)
- Active cases: 624 (+321 since 9/15/21)
- Total probable test results: 480 (+29 since 9/15/21)
- Total ever hospitalized: 402 (+17 since 9/15/21)
- Individuals recovered: 6,108 (+218 since 9/15/21)
- Total deaths of people confirmed positive: 65 (+3 since 9/15/21)
- Total deaths of people probable results: 13 (+0 since 9/15/21)
- Total number of active investigations by setting: 33 (+13 since 9/15/21)  
Educational facility -18; Long-term care facility -2; Workplace (non-health care) -8; Group housing facility -2; Health care facility -2; Other setting -1
