Columbia County to Hold FREE Johnson & Johnson and Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic in Columbus

Columbus, WI - Columbia County Public Health will be hosting a free walk-in clinic for the Johnson & Johnson (one and done) and Moderna COVID-19 vaccine on Friday, October 15, 2021 from 6:00 am to 9:00 am and 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm at the American Packaging Corporation located at 100 APC Way in Columbus, WI.

Appointments are NOT necessary, however if you would like to register ahead of time, please visit vaccinate.wi.gov (you do not need to choose a clinic site/time/date when pre-registering). We request you practice social distancing and follow appropriate mask requirements. No identification card or insurance card is necessary to receive the vaccine.

You must be 18 years of age for the Johnson and Johnson and Moderna vaccine. The second dose of Moderna will be offered on November 12, 2021. You must be able to stay on site for a 15-minute observation period after receiving either vaccine.
