Columbia County to Hold FREE Johnson and Johnson and Pfizer Vaccine Clinic and FREE COVID-19 testing in Cambria

Cambria, WI - Columbia County Public Health will be hosting a free walk-in clinic for the Pfizer and Johnson & Johnson (one and done) COVID-19 vaccine and drive through COVID-19 nasal swab testing on October 30, November 20 and December 4, 2021 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm at the Cambria Fire Station located at 702 Elizabeth Street in Cambria, WI.

You must be 18 years of age for the Johnson and Johnson vaccine and Pfizer is available for ages 12. Those under 18 years of age must have parent/guardian consent. You must be able to stay on site for a 15-minute observation period after receiving either vaccine. Appointments are NOT necessary, however if you would like to register ahead of time, please visit vaccinate.wi.gov (you do not need to choose a clinic site/time/date when pre-registering). We request you practice social distancing and wear a mask in the clinic. No identification card or insurance card is necessary to receive the vaccine. Please enter the Community Center side of the building for vaccines.

The free testing is open to the community and appointments are NOT necessary. In an effort to save time, **we encourage online registration for testing**. If you do not register online, you will still be tested. Staff on site will assist in the registration process. Registration should be done no sooner than 24 hours prior to the event at <https://register.covidconnect.wi.gov/en-US/> Due to the unknown amount of interest, prepare for potential wait times. It is requested that modes of transportation (vehicles, horse drawn buggies, etc.) form a line and stay in the mode of transportation at all times. The National Guard will be doing the testing, they will be in uniform and full personal protective equipment. Individuals will be contacted with their results within 3-7 business days. Please use the drive through bay to obtain testing services.
