Where: Cambria Fire Department, 702 Elizabeth Street, Cambria, WI 53923

Vaccine Information – Enter Community Center Side of the Building

- The **free vaccine** is open to anyone - 18 years of age and older for Johnson and Johnson and 12* years of age and up for the Pfizer vaccine
- Appointments are NOT necessary; this is a walk-in clinic but you may pre-register at vaccinate.wi.gov
- It is requested that you wear a mask and practice safe social distancing
- No identification card or insurance card is necessary to receive the vaccine
- Those receiving the vaccine will need to stay on site for a 15-minute observation period

* Those under 18 years of age must have parent/guardian consent

COVID-19 Testing Information – Drive Through Bay Door

- The free testing is open to the community and appointments are NOT necessary
- In an effort to save time, we encourage online registration. If you do not register online, you will still be tested. Please register no sooner than 24 hours prior to testing at <https://register.covidconnect.wi.gov/en-US/>
- It is requested that modes of transportation (vehicles, horse drawn buggies, etc.) form a line and stay in the mode of transportation at all times
- No restroom facilities will be available on site, please plan accordingly
- Test results will be provided within 3-7 business days
