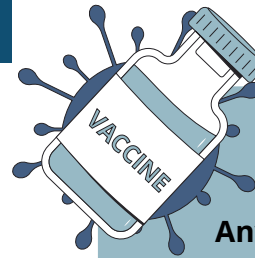

## COVID-19 BOOSTERS

Anyone in Wisconsin 18 years old and older can get a booster dose of COVID-19 vaccine. DHS has announced support of the recommendation of the CDC for the booster at least six months after getting a second dose of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine. People who got the J&J vaccine are also eligible for a booster dose of any of the available COVID-19 vaccines.
