**Delivering Procedures:**

Upon entering the facility, stop at the office. All loads must be covered or enclosed during delivery. Uncovered loads will be refused.

Residential/business waste is accepted at the Hwy. 16 facility.

**Across from Municipal Garage  
 (Washington Street)**

The general public will find that several locations are provided for the unloading of materials. We are concerned for your safety.

**Safety Regulations:**

Small children should be kept inside vehicle. No pets are allowed out of the vehicle at the facility. Drop-off of materials is only allowed during normal business hours. **Fines are imposed to individuals who dump items illegally at recycling sites. All loads are to be tarped.**

**Aluminum:** All Types

- Clean
- Free of liquids
- Cans crushed or uncrushed



**Cardboard:** Corrugated Non Wax, any type

- Clean ■ Flattened

Remove any wax or plastic liners  
Beer/soda cardboard packaging is not recyclable.



**Plastic:** Bottles/Jars

- #1 & #2 ONLY
- Rinsed clean
- Caps removed



At this time, plastic grocery/shopping bags, are not recyclable.

**Tin:** Food cans ONLY

- Rinse clean



**Paper:** Newspaper, magazines, office paper, junk mail

- Clean and dry ONLY



**Used Waste Oil:**

Waste Oil **cannot** be mixed with antifreeze, solvents, kerosene, water, etc. Containers of 5 gals. or less are acceptable.

**Glass:** Bottles and Jars Only, Rinse Clean. Remove Caps.



The following items are not recyclable:  
Window Glass, pottery, ceramics, dishes  
And ovenware. Materials are considered  
demolition-cost is \$4.75 per 100 lbs.
