





















MAP 4-7 **CEMETERIES**








MAP 5-1 LANDS ENROLLED IN FARMLAND PRESERVATION









MAP 5-3 **SOIL ASSOCIATIONS**








MAP 5-4 PRODUCTIVE AGRICULTURAL SOILS










MAP 5-5 **ENVIRONMENTAL CORRIDORS**










MAP 5-6 RARE, THREATENED AND **ENDANGERED SPECIES**









MAP 5-8 **FLOODPLAINS**

Using information gathered in these studies, FEMA engineers and cartographers delineate Special Flood Hazard Areas (FHAs) on FIRMs. A new Flood Insurance Study has been prepared for areas in Columbia County on the Wisconsin & Baraboo Rivers and expected to be released in 2006.










MAP 5-10 WOODLANDS & MANAGED FOREST LAW









MAP 5-11 ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES AND HISTORICAL MARKERS









MAP 8-1 EXISTING LAND USE 2005






